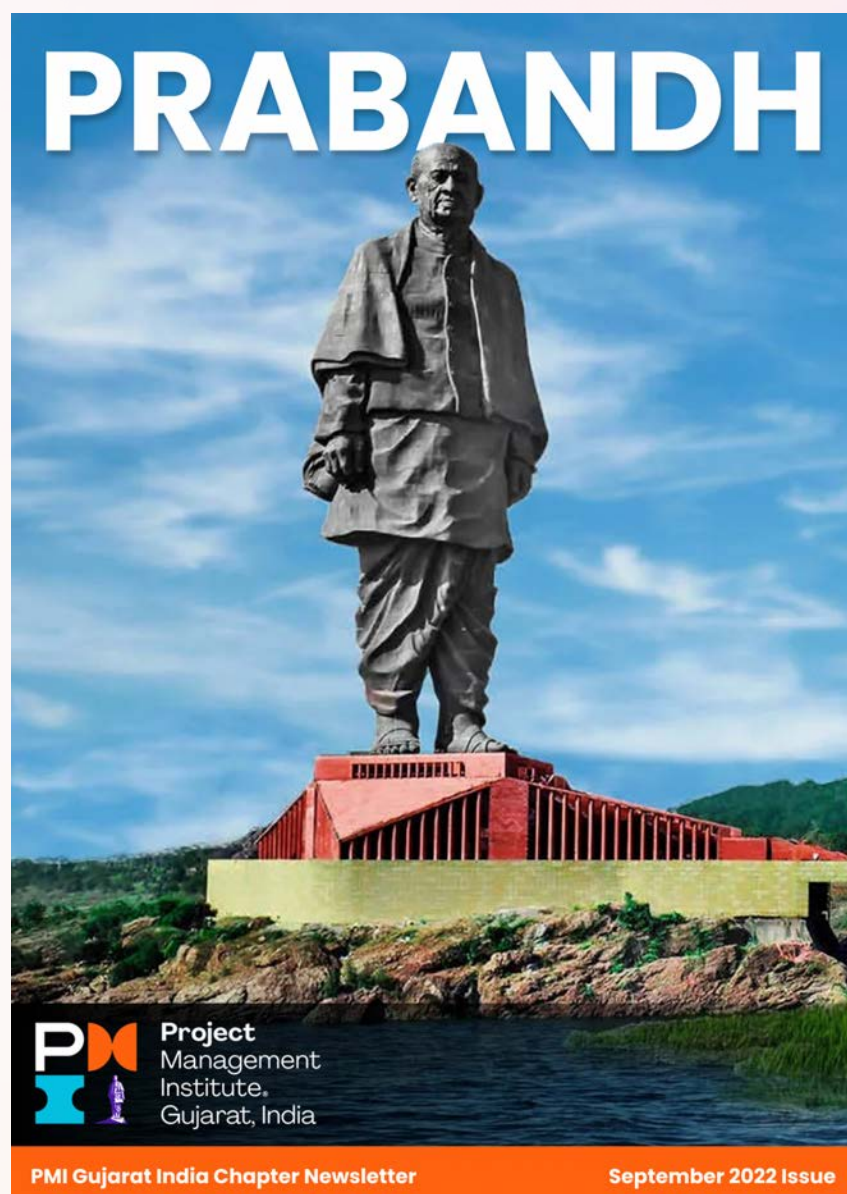

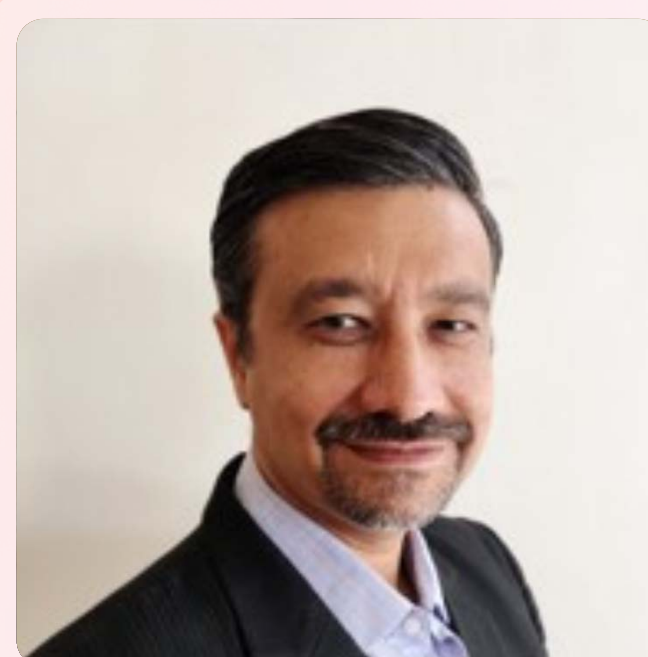

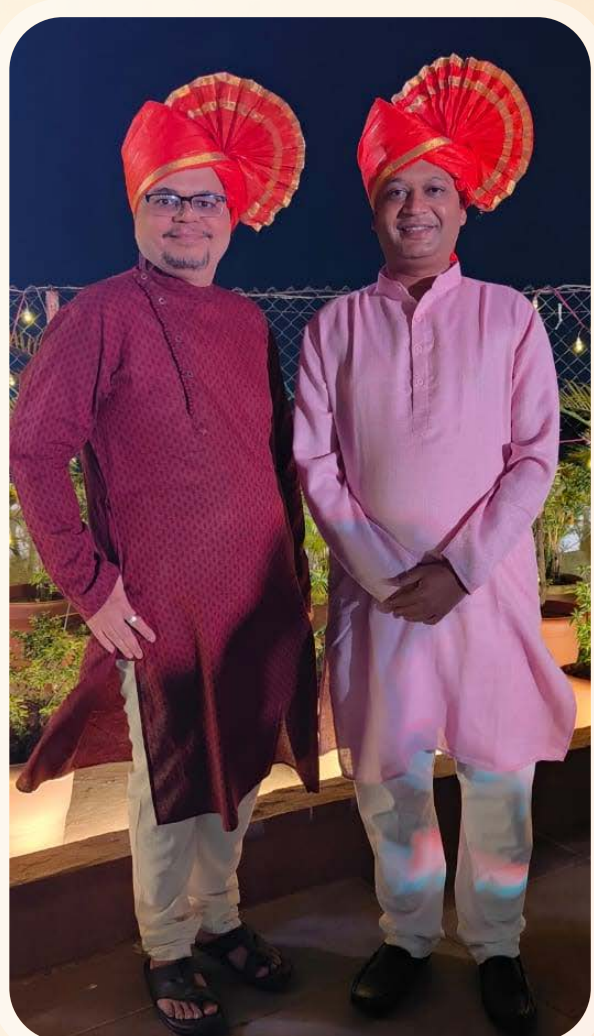
Board Members Participated in Leadership Meet
